Sponsorship Packages

Primary Field Title Sponsor (Only 10 Available):

Includes the following signage: One (1) Scoreboard Sign above or below the field Scoreboard (Size and placement depending on the configuration.); Two (2) dugout and/or score booth signs (Size and placement depending on configuration.); Four (4) signs that are 2' x 4' to be positioned throughout the inside of the complex; One (1) sign that is 4' x 8' to be positioned on or near the exterior complex fence area of the parking lot; One (1) Primary top-level listing on Hart Website with company logo, a brief company statement and description, and a link to company website. Platinum Level Sponsor (Only 40 Available):

Platinum Level Sponsorship Includes: One (1) Outfield Sign that is 5' x 10' to be positioned above the outfield fence of the sponsored team's primary field. Four (4) signs that are 2' x 4' to be position on or near the sponsored team's primary field and/or batting cages; In addition to the team sponsorship signs, the sponsor will receive One (1) sign that is 4' x 8' to be positioned on or near the exterior complex fence area of the parking lot;. One (1) Platinum Level Listing on hart Website with company logo, a brief company statement and description, and a link to the company website. One (1) Sponsor Appreciation Plaque. Price: \$2,000.00* per year.

Gold Level Sponsor:

Gold Level Team Sponsorship Includes: Four (4) signs that are 2' x 4' to be positioned on or near each sponsored team's primary field, hung no higher than 5' off the ground along the sides of the fields and batting cages; One (1) sign that is 4' x 8' to be positioned on or near the exterior complex fence area of the parking lot; One (1) listing on Hart Website with company logo and a link to company website. One (1) Sponsor Appreciation Plaque. Price: \$1,000.00* per year.

Silver Level Sponsor:

Silver Level Team Sponsorship Includes: One (1) sign that is 4' x 8' to be positioned around the exterior of the complex on or near an outfield fence; One (1) Silver Level Sponsor listing on Hart Website with link to company website. One (1) Sponsor Appreciation Plaque. Price: \$500.00 per year.

Bronze Level Sponsor:

Bronze Level Team Sponsorship Includes: One (1) sign that is 2' x 4' to be positioned on or near the sponsored team's primary field; One (1) Bronze Level Sponsor listing on Hart Website with link to company website. One (1) Sponsor Appreciation Plaque. Sponsorship Credit for One (1) Team. Price: \$250.00 per year.

**For Field Title Sponsorships, terms will be three (3) years. We can offer a discount of 15% for 100% pre-payment of Field Title Level sponsorships. Negotiations for an additional three (3) year term should commence during the third year of the contract. *For Platinum & Gold Level Sponsorships, we can offer a discount of 15% for a pre-paid 3-year program or 10% for a pre-paid 2-year program.



Artwork Requirements

All payments must be made upon execution of the sponsorship agreement. Artwork must be approved by the Sponsorship Director and/or Executive Board prior to use. Artwork can be emailed to the Hart Sponsorship Director. Artwork must be sized to fit on 24" x 48", 48" x 96" or 60" x 120" boards, and sent to Hart's sign vendor in a High Resolution EPS or Vector format.
